The Top 100 Apprenticeship Employers celebrates England's outstanding apprenticeship employers in 2024, recognising their commitment to creating new apprenticeships, the diversity of their apprentices, and the number of apprentices who successfully achieve their apprenticeships. The rankings are produced annually by the Department for Education, in partnership with High Fliers Research, who independently assess and rank the nation's top apprenticeship employers.

Entry Criteria

Entries for the **Top 100 Apprenticeship Employers** in 2024 were open to apprenticeship employers in England with a minimum of 250 employees and 25 apprentices. Entries opened on 6th February and closed on 12th April 2024. Each employer entering for the rankings provided three key pieces of data – the number of apprentices that started a new apprenticeship with the employer from 1st April 2023 to 31st March 2024, the diversity of these new apprentices, and the number of apprentices that successfully completed apprenticeships during the year. Employers' entry data was independently verified, weighted according to the size of the employers' workforce, and then scored, in order to calculate the 2024 rankings.
